# Applying Gel Polish: A Step-by-Step Guide

Guide-Practicum: tools, prep, application, timing, common mistakes, safe removal & aftercare

### Tools & Prep

- Nail file (180/240), buffer, cuticle pusher, dehydrator/cleanser, lint-free wipes.
- Base, colour gel, top; UV/LED lamp; cleanup brush.
- Optional: rubber base, primer (sparingly), peel-off guard.
- Prep: wash/dry; push back cuticles; shape; light buff; dust off; dehydrate.

#### **Tools & Prep — Mini Checklist**

$\hfill\Box$ True cuticle removed (no pterygium on plate)
$\square$ Nails fully dry/dehydrated before base.
$\square$ Free edge capped on every coat.
$\square$ Sidewalls cleaned before curing.

### **Step-by-Step Application**


- 1. Apply dehydrator/cleanser. Primer only if needed (thin).
- 2. Base: very thin; cap free edge. Cure per brand.
- 3. Colour 1: thin; 1 mm off cuticle; clean sidewalls. Cure.
- 4. Colour 2: repeat; avoid bulk. Cure.
- 5. Top: seal edges; glossy or matte. Final cure.
- 6. Cleanse if needed; oil cuticles.

## Timing (typical)

Base  $30-60 \text{ s} \cdot \text{Colour } 60-90 \text{ s}$  each  $\cdot \text{Top } 60-90 \text{ s}$  (LED). Follow your brand's lamp specs.

## **Common Mistakes (and fixes)**

- Flooded cuticles/sidewalls: Use less product; work 1 mm away; clean before curing.
- Wrinkling/bubbling: Coats too thick or under-cured apply thinner and follow timing.
- Chipping at free edge: Cap every layer; avoid water/steam for a few hours after.
- Lifting near cuticle: Prep better; remove true cuticle; dehydrate properly.



#### Safe Removal

File top coat to break seal. Soak-off 10–15 min (per brand). Gently push off softened product; never pry. Finish with buffing and oil.

#### Aftercare

- Oil cuticles daily; moisturise after water exposure.
- Avoid harsh cleaning agents; wear gloves for chores.
- Between manis: light buff + hydration, no peeling.
