



What Glasses Will Be in Fashion in 2025?

Infocard + quick checklist: trending shapes, colors & smart lens picks

Shapes & Styles 2025

- Slim rectangles & micro-geometric frames for a sleek tech vibe.
- Soft cat-eye and almond silhouettes — modern, not vintage-heavy.
- Sculptural bridges and semi-rimless designs for lightness.
- Oversized ovals with thin metal temples for a 'quiet luxury' look.

Face Shape Guide

- Oval — almost any shape; try soft rectangles to sharpen features.
- Round — angular rectangles/hexagons to add structure.
- Square — round/oval edges to soften jawline.
- Heart — cat-eye or light-bottom frames to balance forehead.
- Diamond — top-heavy styles or gentle ovals.

Colors & Materials

- Tones: champagne, cola-brown, soft graphite, translucent moss, ice blue.
- Finishes: matte acetates, brushed titanium, bio-based cellulose, recycled metals.
- Pro tip: translucent fronts with metal temples = lighter look on camera.

Lenses in 2025

- Subtle tints (tea, smoke, pale blue) for screen-friendly softness.
- Blue-light filters with low color cast; skip overly yellow options.
- Photochromic for commuters; oleophobic and anti-static coatings as baseline.



Quick Fit Checklist

- Pupillary distance centered (no inward/outward eye drift).
- Bridge sits flush—no pinch marks after 30–60 min.
- Temples hug gently; no hot spots.
- Top rim shouldn't cut through brows.
- Frame width $\approx$ face width; cheeks don't push the frame.

Tip: Bring a daylight selfie and compare how rim thickness and tone affect your under-eyes and brows on camera.
