

How to Choose a Stylish Umbrella for Any Weather

Beauty Umbrella: Combines functionality with fashion; a style statement for rain or shine.

Trends: Transparent/semi-transparent domes, automatic foldables, decorative handles.

Materials: Aluminum (light), steel (strong), nylon (fast-drying), polyester (UV protection), satin (luxury).

Materials

- Frames: Aluminum (light, flexible), steel (sturdy), hybrid (balanced).
- **Fabrics**: Nylon (light, fast-drying), polyester (UV protection, prints), satin (luxury, delicate).
- Durability: Reinforced joints, rubberized ferrules for windy/wet climates.

Care Tips

- **Drying**: Open in ventilated area, away from sun; hang upside down if needed.
